Thank you for your letter of 15 May 2015, which we received on 18 May 2015 by courier. The European Chess Union (hereinafter "ECU") takes note of the appeal that the Appellants listed in your letter, namely Messrs. Silvio Danailov, Vladimir Sakotic and Sava Stoisavljevic, filed at the Court of Arbitration for Sport on 7 May 2015 against the World Chess Federation (FIDE) with respect to the decision of the FIDE Ethics Commission on the admissibility of the complaints of ECU and Montenegro Chess Federation versus the Appellants.

In this connection, kindly note that ECU does not wish to participate as interested party in the present arbitration proceedings of the afore-referenced case nr. CAS2015/A/4062. However, ECU explicitly reserves the right to participate in possible future proceedings before the Court of Arbitration for Sport on the merits of ECU's complaint to the FIDE Ethics Commission against the Appellants.
